




















# PAINTBRUSH TOOLS

HERE IS AN IN-DEPTH EXPLANATION OF THE PAINTBRUSH TOOLS:

| <p>Both sets of scissors are tools to use for cutting and copying. With the star scissors you click and drag to form a shape around the items you wish to cut or copy. Then click in the middle of the object and drag it to its destination or press Ctrl and drag to make a copy.</p> |  | <p>These scissors are for cutting and copying. To use you click and drag to make a box around the object you wish to cut or copy.</p>  |
| <p>This spray paint tool enables you to draw or colour with what looks like spray paint.</p>  |  | <p>Click here to use the keyboard to type letters onto your picture. Change the font and size using the TEXT button at the top.</p>  |
| <p>Eraser-this eraser only erases the colour that you have specified at the bottom.</p>   |  | <p>Eraser-choose the size of eraser by choosing a thickness of line at the bottom. Click and drag to erase.</p>  |
| <p>Paint Roller-this will fill colour in where you place it and click. Make sure that the shape you wish to fill is closed.</p>   |  | <p>Paintbrush-click and drag you mouse to draw with the paintbrush. Choose line thickness at the bottom left and colour at the bottom.</p>   |
| <p>Curved lines-this tool allows you to make nicely curved lines. Click and drag to make a line, then click on one point of the line to curve it. Click on another part to make another curve.</p>  |  | <p>Line tool. Click and drag to draw a line. Press SHIFT to create a perfectly straight line.</p>  |
| <p>Empty Box-click and drag to create an empty box. Choose the thickness of your border at the bottom.</p>  |  | <p>Filled Box-click and drag to create a coloured box. Press SHIFT to make a perfect square (works with empty box too).</p>  |
| <p>Rounded Box-click and drag to create a box with rounded edges.</p>   |  | <p>Filled Rounded Box-click and drag to create a coloured rounded box. SHIFT makes a perfectly square box.</p>   |
| <p>Circle-Click and drag to create an empty circle.</p>   |  | <p>Filled Circle-click and drag to create a filled circle. Press SHIFT to make a perfect circle (works on empty circle too).</p>   |
| <p>Polygon Tool-click and drag to create a line, then click and your line will connect where ever you click. Use this to create irregular, many sided shapes. Make sure that your last point connects exactly to the first one (your line will become more bold when it connects).</p>  |  | <p>Filled Polygon Tool-click and drag to create a line, then click and your line will connect to where ever you click. Your shape will not fill up until you connect your last point to exactly where you started.</p> |
