Other Suggestions for Practice:

1. Put the syllables on cards (2 per syllable) and play Concentration. Read each syllable as the card is turned over and find the pairs.
2. Play “Go fish” with the pairs of syllables all mixed up. The player with the most pairs wins. The child must read each pair at the end.
3. Take a large cookie sheet or cake tin. Fill with salt and practice printing a given syllable or word with the finger; the kinesthetic sense of touch combined with visual and auditory helps lock it into the memory.
4. Use the syllable cards to make nonsense words of two, three, four etc. syllables eg. “batima” or “bifatozu”
5. Use the syllable cards to build the words on the BAVAZA wordlist. Also write in the salt tray and slide the finger underneath as the word is repeated. Have fun!
