Police Interviewing of Students

1. The Board seeks to cooperate with police in investigations, while not compromising the legal rights of the students in its care.
2. Generally, students on school premises or at school-sponsored events are not to be formally interviewed by police officers as part of a formal investigation process.
3. The Board recognizes it is possible, due to extenuating circumstances or emergent situations that a member of the RCMP might need to interview a student as part of a formal investigation. In this case, the attached regulation will apply.
