SCHOOL COMPLETION CERTIFICATE

A school completion certificate recognizes that a student has participated in a planned set of goals or program of study that has been determined collaboratively by the parent/guardian, student and school and set out in an individual education plan (IEP) and school completion plan or graduation portfolio.

The school completion certificate:

- reflects a diversity of learners.
- is the school district's recognition that a student has completed a formal educational program and is prepared to move onto to another field of interest.
- demonstrates that the student has successfully achieved the goals as set out in the plan and has had appropriate attendance.

The attached regulation outlines the achievement of a school completion certificate.
